

**Context:** We have recently reopened our In-Tay-Twined gallery, a refreshed look at the relationship between jute growing regions of Southeast Asia and Dundee. We have worked with lots of partners to make sure that we are telling stories from diverse perspectives.

We are looking for someone to make a short video that demonstrates the shifting borders of the South Asian continent between the mid 1700s and 1971 at key points highlighted by our interpretation.

**Some parameters:**

- The work can be original or draw upon open access images such as maps.
- The video should be no longer than 2 and a half minutes and must be able to be viewed on a phone screen.
- The fee is £940 (inclusive of materials and VAT where applicable), or the equivalent of 4 days at Scottish Artists Union rates.
- We will provide access support as needed for you to make your work, including baseline research to get you started.

**Some pointers:**

- Words we use to describe the gallery: Uplifting, Reflective, Personal.
- A personal connection to Bengal/Kolkata/the Jute trade is a positive for us
- Our audience are mostly interested adults and families.
- We would encourage artists not to use AI in the creation of the artwork.
- The work must be completed by July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026.

**To Apply:**

- 500 words max about your idea – can be written or recorded (4 minutes)
- 250 words about you can be written or recorded, including confirmation of where in the UK you are based (2 minutes)
- A link to your website or somewhere else with information about your work,
- A short note outlining access support you might need.
