Dundee Heritage Trust.

Dundee Heritage Trust is a registered charity preserving and interpreting Dundee's rich industrial past. It operates two 5 star multi-award winning museums – RRS Discovery/Discovery Point and Verdant Works – both with Recognised Collections of National Significance.

Discovery Point interprets the amazing history of one of the world's most important historic ships - the Dundee-built *Discovery* - including her famous voyage to the Antarctic in 1901 under the command of Captain Robert Falcon Scott.

Verdant Works is one of the nation's most important textile museums, telling the story of Dundee's incredible jute industry, which at its peak in 1900 employed 50,000 people and supplied much of the world's demand for jute goods.
